

IMPLEMENTATION SUPPLIES GUIDELINES

CAN NOT FUND

- Money that goes to individuals
 - Example: stipends, gift cards, paid internships, etc.
- Money to government institutions
 - Example: Schools, districts, local government branches, etc.
- Food with the following exceptions:
 - For emergency kits that are stored at a school or other communal space. This food is to be consumed if, and only if, an event occurs that warrants the kit
- The purchase of supplies from the beneficiary of the project
 - Example: Buying trees from a conservation organization, then donating the trees back to that same conservation organization to be planted on their land
- The purchase of supplies or equipment that end up personally owned
 - Example: A projector that one individual teacher owns

PREFER NOT TO FUND

- School or classroom supplies that can be used generically
 - Example: Printers, cameras, markers/crayons, etc
